

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUANCE OF PROVISIONAL  
LICENSE.**

The commission shall issue a provisional license to practice funeral directing and/or embalming to an applicant who:

- (1) is at least 18 years of age;
- (2) has completed the educational requirements of Texas Occupations Code Section 651.253 or is enrolled in an accredited school or college of mortuary science;
- (3) is employed by a funeral director and/or to learn funeral directing or embalming under the instruction and supervision of the funeral director and/or embalmer; (The terms of employment must include service by the provisional license holder of at least 17 hours a week or 73 hours a month; under actual working conditions and under the personal supervision of a funeral director and/or embalmer.)
- (4) files an application for a provisional license on a form approved by the commission;
- (5) pays any required application or license fee;
- (6) complies with the requirements of this chapter and of the Commission
